Lady Mustangs Win 5th Consecutive Hiawatha Tourney

The Rock Creek Lady Mustangs won their fifth consecutive Hiawatha Invitational Tournament by crushing the Horton Chargers 53-27 in the championship game. The Mustangs were led by Lizz Herrs who had 23 points, 8 rebounds, and 5 steals in the victory. Rock Creek never trailed in the game opening a 10-2 first quarter lead and then a 19-11 lead at the half. In the third quarter, the 'Stangs exploded with a huge quarter to put the game out of reach at 38-12. Other game scorers include Caitliné Christenson with 9 points, Bailey Elliott with 8 points, Megan Srna with 7 points, Shiann Bruce with 3 points, Codi Ebert with 2 points, and Annette Trieb with 1 point. The Mustangs placed three players: Lizz Herrs, Megan Srna, and Shiann Bruce on the Ten Member All-Tournament Team. With the win, the 'Stangs move their record to 12-2.

In the Mustangs first round game the Lady 'Stangs destroyed tournament host Hiawatha 53-23. After a slow start to the game, Rock Creek outscored the Red Storm 35-14 in the next two quarters to ease to their tenth victory of the season and a ticket into the semifinals against the Marysville Bulldogs.

To no one's surprise, the semifinal game against the long-time tourney rival, Marysville, proved to be the toughest of the tournament games for the Mustangs. For the past six years, the championship of the Hiawatha Tournament has boiled down to a tight contest with the Bulldogs, with the Mustangs winning five of those six championship games. This year the annual matchup was held in the semifinals. Regardless, the outcome of this game, as it has had many times before, came down in the final seconds of the game. Shiann Bruce hit one of two free throws with 18 seconds left to give the Mustangs their final margin, but the 'Stangs had to survive a long 3-point attempt by the Bulldogs to secure the win.
