#### **What Floats Your Boat?**

A strong piece of cardboard and some well-placed duct tape, that's what keeps your boat floating. The physics class traveled to the Onaga Hospital pool on March 30 to test the boats they made using un-waxed cardboard and duct tape only at the seams. Prior to the day, the students had discussed buoyant forces and made a model boat for practice.

The class "competes" against the Blue Valley physics class in two categories: fastest time down the length of the pool once and most times back and forth. We broke two records this year and Rock Creek took both of them! Adam Schmitz and Michael Parker hold the record for fastest time at 12.73 seconds with their aptly named boat "S.S. Cheetah" (top right picture). Ben Peterson and Zac Saueressig (bottom right picture) set a new record of 20 times back and forth. In fact, after 20 times back and forth, they paddled over to the side of the pool and said "we're done!" before climbing out of their boat and removing their boat from the water. Typically boats sink first then we know they're done, but their boat actually outlasted them!
